

### Supply List for Bas-Relief Soap (Advanced Category):

1. Clay (500g or 17.6 oz) Pottery clay is recommended. Check your local hobby store first, then check online. It is difficult to find less than 5 lb pottery clay online:

2. Plaster (550 g or 19.4 oz) Check your local hobby store first! <https://www.amazon.com/53005-Plaster-Molding-Material-4-4-Pound/dp/B000BPK8NS/>
3. Pourable Silicone (200 g or 7 oz) Check your local hobby store first!

4. Standard silicone mold with individual cavities – round, square, heart, oval, etc. (round with straight sides works best. You can also use a PVC pipe, cut to size or a round plastic bottle cut to size!) (I was able to use an oval shaped mold, but it was a lot more difficult because the sides weren't straight!)
